

Getting Back to God Genesis 35:1-5

Why return to serving God?

- He had protected Jacob in confrontation with Esau verse 1 and 3.
- God had commanded him to return verse 1 and 31:3
- Experienced the wrath of God for disobedience- Chapter 34 Dinah raped, sons massacre city of Shechem, home in a mess.

The steps...

Father lay hold on household vs 2

Jacob let his home get out of hand, Dinah raped, boys massacre \$
Sorry daddies have led this nation into ruin, if ever restored fathers
with retake household \$ punks loud music \$
JOSUHA "as for me and my house we will serve the Lord."

Rid false gods vs 2

Rachel stole \$ ours gods...it is illegal to love hobby more than House
of God \$ we can't get back Sunday nite as our God TV won't let us
\$ 1st commandment no other gods

Bathe and change garments vs 2

Hidden sin in all \$ David said I will hide sin with Bathsheba , but
later had to plead "purge me with hyssop" \$ you sitting on
consecrated ground tonight cause we here to worship God \$ God's
children ought to look different, smell different \$ Priest had a dress
code to enter into tabernacle

Put off ornaments of world vs 4

Earrings- they picked this up from watching world \$ Israel like other
nations, TN lottery like GA \$ come ye out and be separate
