* Recount David/Bethsheba

* Nathan's sermon vs 1-9

1) Sword shall never depart from thine house VERSE 10

* Amnon rape Tamar 13:1-14

Broke David's (father's) heart 13:21

Hatred between Absalom/Amnon 13:22; no speak 2 years
13:23

(Note: Absalom and Ta-mar's mom Ma-a-chah, Amnon
mom A-hin-o-am)

* Absalom plot to kill Tamar for his transgression Has his
servants make him drunk and then slew him 13:28-29.

* David, angry at the actions of Absalom for killing
Amnon, was alienated from his son Absalom for 2 years no
see each other 14:28

* Absalom plotted to steal kingdom from father David
15:1-6.

The scheme worked and David and his servants had to
flee from the kingdom 15:13-16

2) Naaman said more VERSE 11

* Remember David left 10 maids behind to keep the palace
of the Kingdom when he fled. Naaman said a neighbor will
have your wives. Little did he know that neighbor would be
his own son Absalom 16:20-23

Notice verse 23 "was as if a man had inquired at the oracles
of God." No reason to believe Ahithophel heard Naaman
preach his sermon to King David. Yet, the Bible said his
words were as spoken by God. As if he had written a book
and Ahithophel read it, as if God had given a speech and
Ahithophel heard the speech. One thing you better never
hope happens to you----GOD SICKS THE DEVIL ON
YOU.
